### **Duke University Talent Identification Program**

- The Duke University Talent Identification Program provides a variety of opportunities for gifted and talented students. TIP offers a talent search for students in fourth, fifth and seventh grade, who score in the 95% percentile on standardized testing, or have a score of at least 125 on an IQ test. Students in fourth or fifth grade receive a chance to take the EXPLORE test, typically given in eighth grade. The program also offers students in seventh grade a choice of taking either the ACT or SAT college entrance exam. TIP provides advanced learners opportunities to take part in special summer programs and camps, as well as school year courses and weekend conferences at Duke University.
