

Five Stars Pathway: Engaging Girls in Science through Multigenerational Mentors (EPOESS) – at Exploration Station (AGU)

In addition to presenting at Exploration Station, the Five Stars project also brought a group of teenage girls as participants. 10 middle and high school girls participating in the Five Stars program at Girls Inc. of Alameda County in Oakland, California, visited all the activity tables at Exploration Station. They were accompanied by a female UC Berkeley graduate student in astronomy and a Space Science Lab scientist. This experience gave the teenage girls an opportunity to learn about the electromagnetic spectrum and meet with female scientists in heliophysics.
